School Opening/closing year 2022

The School opened on 26th September, 2022 for third term and closed 25th November, 2022, This year we had four terms instead of the normal three terms per year, this is because the Ministry of Education wanted to cover up for the time wasted during the Covid-19 pandemic so they had to rearrange the days to fit one calendar year. Now come next year 2023 the school calendar will go back to normal. We shall resume school on 23rd January, 2023.

K.C.P.E. Exams

Our class eight candidates sat for their exams in March 2022 and regardless of shortened school dates they really did us proud by performing better than last year. They had a mean score of 317, though there is still room for improvement. They all managed to join secondary schools. This year we have sat for K.C.P.E. exams twice, that is in March and now in November. The Class eight have sat for their final exam from 28th November to 30th November, 2023 and we are waiting for the results which will be out before the end of the year.

Grade six

This is our pioneer C.B.C. (Competency Based Curriculum) class. They have also sat for their final assessment test known as Kenya Primary School Education Assessment (K.P.S.E.A.) from 28th November to 30th November, 2022. They shall be joining Junior Secondary School in January 2023. The Government has authorized that they should continue in their current schools for another three years before joining Senior Secondary school after grade nine. We are expecting to accommodate more grade seven pupils in our junior secondary school since not many schools in our area were awarded the certificates because they did not meet the requirements to have a junior secondary school in their current schools. Some of these requirements were for the existing schools to have enough classrooms and a laboratory. We are lucky to have acquired the certificate for this.

We are also planning to construct a dining hall on top of the kitchen due to limited space as per our Engineer's advice Mr. Daniel Manza. Currently our children eat from outside but it will be better if we managed to construct a dining hall for them.
